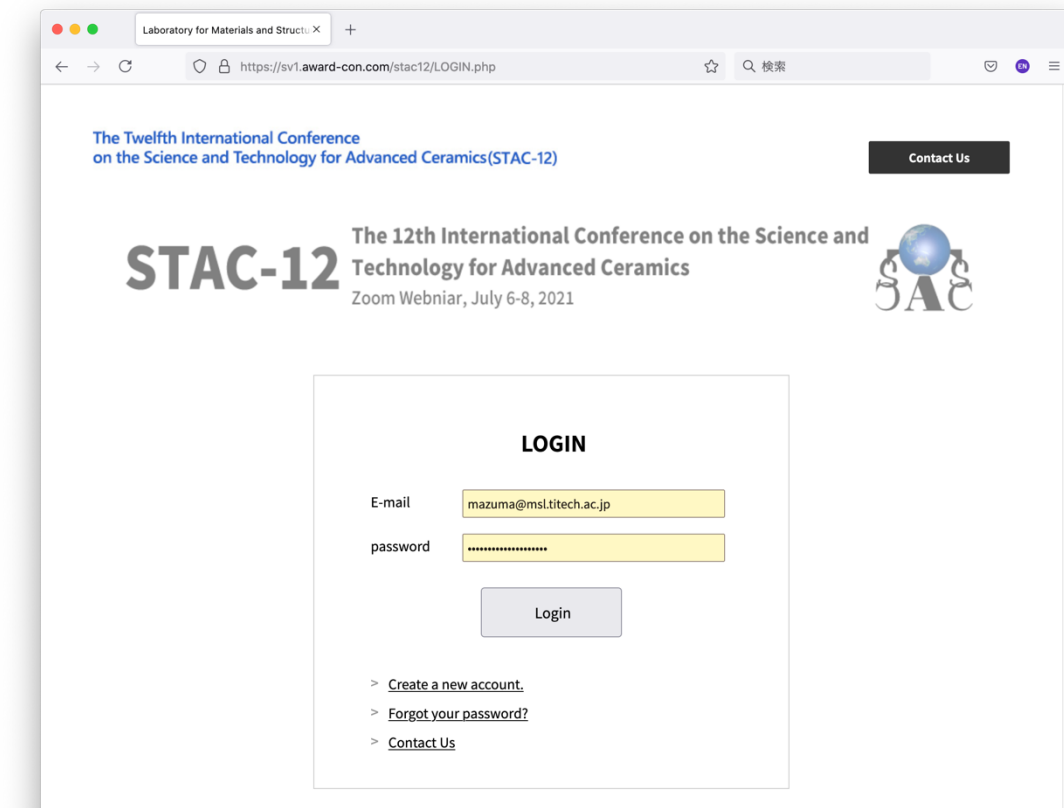


# How to join STAC-12

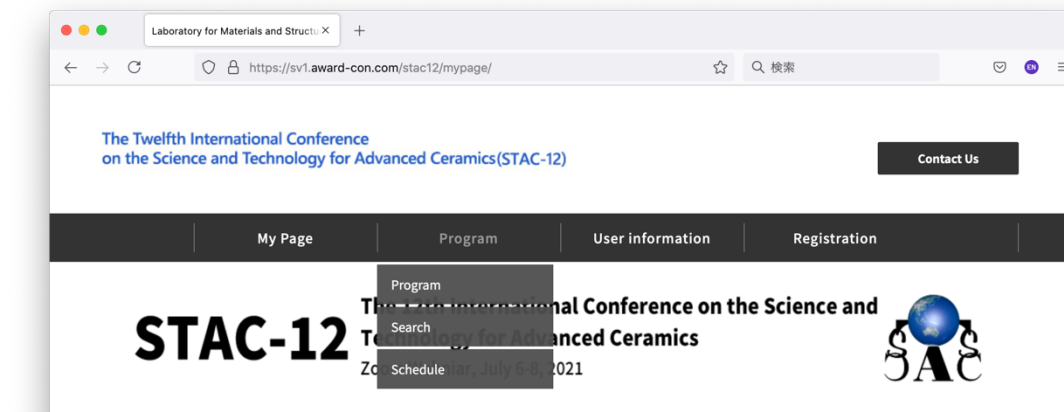
Access <https://sv1.award-con.com/stac12/> and log in.

Choose "Program"

## Notes for oral sessions

### \* Speakers

1. Enter the zoom meeting room at least 10 min. before the session starts.
2. Check the audio, video and screen share.
3. Mute and Stop Video until the session chair prompts to turn these on.
4. Share the screen and start the talk.
5. When finished, Mute and Stop Video.

### \* Audience

1. Enter the meeting room with Mute and Stop Video.
2. Recording and screen shot are prohibited.
3. To ask a question, Reaction\_Raise Hand. Unmute and speak after allowed by the chair person.
4. Mute and Stop Video again after the question.

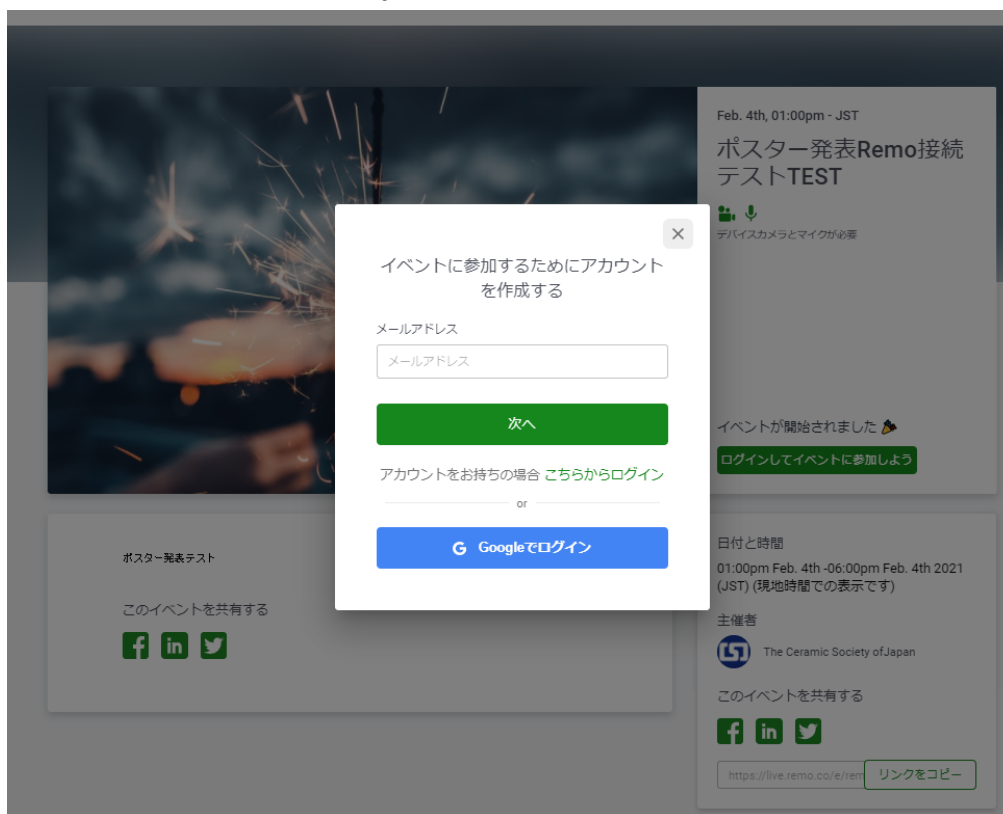

1.3.2. In order to join Remo, you need an account. Please create an account with any address.



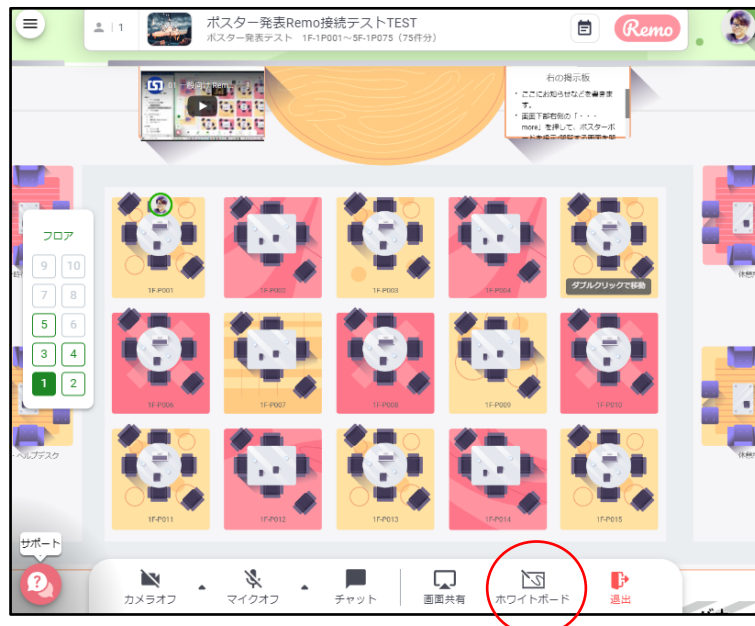
1.3.3. Please allow the use of the microphone and camera according to the screen display.
